Weekend Pool Guest Limit

The Clark County Combined Health District (CCCHD) and the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) have provided guidelines for swimming pool operations. Because of the spacing requirements, please limit your pool guests on the weekends to 1 per member present. Spacing shouldn't be an issue through the week. Our primary obligation is to our dues paying members. If you wish to see full details of the health department guidelines, please refer to the May 28, 2020, email to Polo Club members.

Pool Toy Storage Shed

If you are using the toy storage shed at the pool, please note that the left door has latches at the top and bottom that must be opened before opening the door and the left door must be shut tightly and the latches both closed before closing and putting the keeper through the handles of the right door. Both must be closed tightly to prevent the shed from being blown over again in a storm. If that happens, we will have to abandon the shed and everyone will have to take their floats, etc., home and bring them back each time. The inspector will not allow toys to be stored in the equipment shed. Thanks for your understanding and help.
